SPRING FEST 2021

To mark the birth anniversary of Late S. Jodh Singh ji, Founder Chairman of JIS Group Educational Initiatives, Narula Public School administration organized an **online Talent Contest**, titled, **“Spring Fest 2021” in February, 2021**. The talent contest witnessed enthusiastic participation of students from different schools of Kolkata & Hooghly. **316 students registered** for participation in four different categories of competitions, conducted in the **virtual mode**.

JUDGEMENT METHODOLOGY: Out of the total entries received for **‘Attire Speaks’ & ‘Nurture Nature’** (Contest 1 & Contest 2), the best four entries were selected by the judges for posting on the school Facebook page. Based on the **number of likes by viewers on FB**, 1st, 2nd, 3rd & consolation prize winners were declared in each category. For the **Podcast contest & Patriotic Songs contest** (Contest 3 & Contest 4), the awards were based on judge’s choice.

AWARDS: E-Certificates will be awarded to all the participants & winners in different categories. The winners will also be felicitated in a special prize distribution ceremony, which will be planned once the State Government grants permission to reopen educational institutions up to the middle school level.

1. Competition 1: Attire Speaks

A costume designing/ fancy dress competition, where the participants dressed up using recycled materials on the themes:

- a) ‘Jai Jawan Jai Kisan’ OR
- b) ‘This is what I want to be...’

The entries of top 4 contestants based on the Judge’s Choice were posted on Facebook and the winners were declared based on the number of likes received by each entry.
